NEW! B.E.A.R. CAMP FOR DYSLEXIA – DAY CAMP

Coed Entering Grades 6-10

Two Week Session, Monday-Friday | 9am-5pm* | June 29 – July 10, 2026

B.E.A.R. Camp for Dyslexia is a two-week specialized reading program for middle and high-school-aged children with dyslexia. During a typical day at camp, students use the state-of-the-art computer labs and classrooms for instruction and tutoring in the morning and then join the other campers for lunch and afternoon programs like swimming, archery, sports, arts and crafts, and more.

B.E.A.R. Camp is designed for students entering grades 6-10 with a functional reading level between grades 4 through 7 or a non-emotional/behavioral IEP for reading support.
